Code of Conduct for All Members

Our Commitment

Dundee Darts Academy is committed to providing a safe, positive, inclusive, and respectful environment for all children and young people. This Code of Conduct reflects the principles of Child Protection in Sport (sportscotland) and applies to everyone connected with the Academy.

Who This Code Applies To

This Code applies to children and young people, parents and carers, coaches, staff, volunteers, committee members, and anyone representing the Academy.

Expected Standards of Behaviour

All members must treat others with respect, behave appropriately, follow instructions, use suitable language, respect facilities, and raise concerns promptly. Bullying, harassment, discrimination, or abusive behaviour will not be tolerated.

Staff and Volunteers

Staff and volunteers must prioritise child welfare, act as role models, maintain boundaries, follow safeguarding procedures, and report concerns immediately.

Children and Young People

Children should treat others kindly, play fairly, follow guidance, respect differences, and speak to a trusted adult if worried.

Parents and Carers

Parents and carers must support Academy values, behave respectfully, raise concerns through appropriate channels, and never engage in hostile behaviour.

Safeguarding

All members must never ignore concerns, respect confidentiality, and report safeguarding issues immediately to the DDA executive group or coaches.

Social Media and Online Behaviour

Members must behave respectfully online. Malicious use of social media—including bullying, harassment, false statements, sharing disputes, or creating fake accounts—is strictly prohibited and may result in removal or referral to external bodies.

Photography and Media

Photos and videos may only be taken or shared with consent. Images of children must never be shared without permission.

Equality, Diversity and Inclusion

The Academy promotes inclusion and will not tolerate discriminatory behaviour.

Alcohol, Smoking and Substances

Alcohol, drugs, smoking, and vaping are not permitted for coaches or volunteers during Academy activities.

Reporting and Breaches

Concerns should be reported through Academy procedures. Breaches of this Code may result in disciplinary action or removal.

Agreement

All members must agree to this Code as a condition of involvement.
